Important information...

- All children need to be toilet trained, wearing knickers or jocks. No pull-ups.
- Lunch, morning tea & drinks need to be put in the baskets inside the sliding cupboard. Meat or cheese sandwiches and yoghurt is to be placed in the fridge, **clearly named**.
- Children's items need to be CLEARLY named.
- Your child will require a change of clothes.
- We have a healthy eating policy at our centre. This means no lollies or lolly type items or chocolates. No nuts; we are a nut-free centre.
- Children are to be picked up promptly at 2pm.
- Your child will participate in lots of messy play so please dress them appropriately; no new clothes, no shoe string tops or dresses, no tank tops.
- Please apply sunscreen to your child in the mornings and provide wide-brimmed sunhat in term 1 and 4.

FEES 2021

\$55 per child, per day.

Fees are charged upfront each term and can be paid at the office or directly into our bank account.

We are registered for the Child Care Subsidy. The Child Care Subsidy is income and activity tested and paid directly to us to reduce the fees that eligible families pay.

You can apply for the Child Care Subsidy online or in person through Centrelink. To apply online, visit the Department of Human Services website. This is your responsibility to organise.
